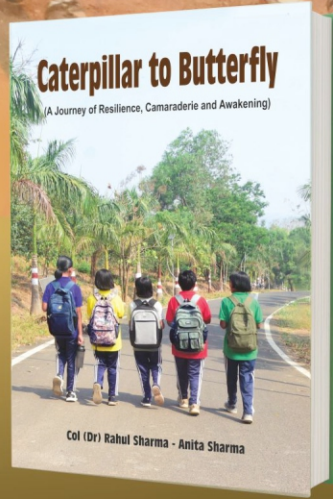

Inter House Skating Competition

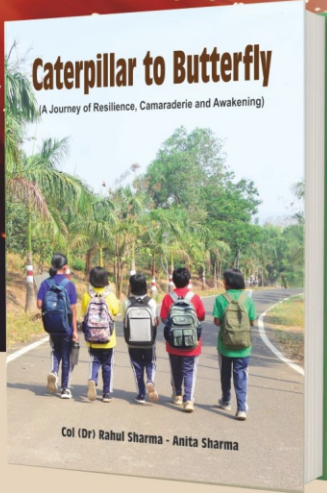
